2010 IP Specialty Soybean Program

Signed contracts must be returned to Program Director Joe Taft to guarantee premiums.

Minimum Specifications:

Moisture: 14% maximum discounted to 13%

Test Weight: 56# minimum

Damage: 1.0% maximum

Purity: Must be 99% varietal pure and test neg. on strip test

Heat Damage: None

Foreign Mat.: Deducted over 1%

Splits & Small: 10% maximum, otherwise non-GMO

No dirt covered or stained soybeans

Max 2% shriveled and immature

Max 4% cracked seed coats

Max 1% soybeans of other colors (includes brown swirl)

No second crop soybeans

No artificial drying

Must meet US #1 Grade Factors

Soybeans must qualify for human consumption and approval of The DeLong Co. or be subject to rejection.

All Soybeans grown as identity preserved, variety specific for food grade premiums.

If Soybean fail to make IP food beans they will be accepted as non-GMO soybeans as long as non-GMO specifications are met.

The DeLong Co., Inc reserves the right to request seed receipts, inspect fields and reject soybeans if they do not meet food quality grade.

2010 Non-GMO Soybean Program

Any, Non-GMO soybean is acceptable and in addition any rejected IP food soybean is acceptable as long as it meets Non-GMO specifications. Soybeans must have a negative strip test. Premium +.50 CBOT.

**Note there is no additional premium for farm stored buyer's call
To assure these premiums we must have a signed production agreement
